

ORDINANCE NO. 80

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A PORTION OF WONDER STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS, PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAME, TOGETHER WITH ALL SANITARY SEWERS AND INCIDENTAL WORK, AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR SAID GRADING, DRAINING CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAID PORTION OF WONDER STREET.

- Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that that portion of Wonder Street from its intersection with Dell Street to its intersection with Miller Court, within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., shall be accepted and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.
- Section 2. That the width of said portion of Wonder Street shall be established and the same hereby is established at sixty feet; that the widths of the roadway and sidewalks shall be established and the same hereby are established at twenty feet from face to face of curb for roadway, and twenty feet from face of curb to property line for sidewalks.
- Section 3. That said portion of Wonder Street from its intersection with Dell Street to its intersection with Miller Court, including the necessary highway intersections and returns, shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded, drained, curbed and paved with a reinforced cement concrete pavement or a concrete base with a bituminous surface together with all necessary sanitary sewer, storm sewer, man-holes, drop inlets and other work incidental thereto in accordance with the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer, as prayed for by a petition of a majority of property owners in interest and in number, abutting on said portion of Wonder Street, acknowledged on the 29th day of December A.D. 1928.
- Section 4. That the committee on highways and sewers shall be authorized and hereby is authorized to proceed with the advertisements and completion of said work on the foot front plan in accordance with the petition on file for the improvements of said portion of Wonder Street.
- Section 5. That one-third of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said portion of Wonder St. together with all incidental work thereto, shall be appropriated and the same hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer authorized to make payments of same from time to time on estimates prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by the Borough Council.
- Section 6. That two-thirds of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said portion of Wonder St. together with all incidental work thereto and the total cost of all curbing and sanitary sewer, as provided by the Borough Ordinance, shall be assessed and the same hereby is assessed on the foot front plan to the abutting property owners.
- Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
