

**ORDINANCE OF SOUTHMONT BOROUGH, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2012**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of Southmont Borough, Cambria County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1- TAX RATE:

That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within said municipality subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2012 as follows:

Tax Rate for general purposes, the sum of thirteen (13.0) mills of each dollar of assessed valuation.

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of thirteen (13.0) mills.

SECTION 2 – PENALTIES:

All taxpayers who fail to make payment of taxes levied against them for four months after the date of the tax notice shall be charged a penalty of ten percent (10%) which penalty shall be added to the taxes by the tax collector and shall be collected by her.

SECTION 3 – ALL OTHER TAXES:

All other tax rates and taxes assessed under the Local Tax Enabling Act are unchanged from the previous year.

SECTION 4. REPEALERS:

That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance by and the same are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
