## Property Maintenance & Streets Committee Meeting March 11, 2025 4:00 p.m.

The committee reviewed the estimates provided by PennDOT for the proposed paving of Langhorne Avenue, State Street from Dell Street to Leon Street, the curve on Southmont Blvd., Harding Street, Corn Alley, and Logan Street. Mrs. Layton reported that Mike Bowser from PennDOT suggested the borough bid its own portion of Langhorne Avenue instead of sharing the cost with the City of Johnstown since their section is worse and will require a different paving plan, which may end up costing the borough more.

The committee reviewed the recent updated draft to the proposed sidewalk ordinance and suggested residents be given an initial two-year time frame to complete necessary work with a reminder to be sent after one year instead of requiring work to be completed within sixty days.
