

ORDINANCE NO. 193

PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF A PORTION OF BLUFF STREET FORMERLY KNOWN AS BLUFF ALLEY AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that Bluff Street beginning at Station 0 plus 0 at the intersection of the center line of Otis Street thence by the center line of Bluff Street north $86^{\circ}-59'$ West 698.42 feet to Station 6 plus 98.42 on line of Lot no. 1014 on the Southmont Plan of Lots, the place of ending; Said Bluff Street being forty (40) feet in width composed of a twenty-four (24) foot roadway and an eight (8) foot sidewalk on each side shall be accepted and the same is hereby accepted as a public highway for public use.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
